Since YPA is located in South Florida, priority will generally be given to applications from this area, however, applications for other locations will be considered.

Among other factors YPA considers are the number and age of anticipated participants, whether your application provides for financially challenged and special needs youth, and the amount and quality of instruction and services being provided. In considering your application, YPA does not discriminate based upon race, gender, LGBTQ status or ethnicity. If your application is approved, you will be required to provide YPA with a final report, including photos, describing the outcome of your program and permission for YPA to use your information and photos for marketing, fund raising and on our website.
